Roughly 360 reference entries provide fundamental information about specific topics related to religion in American history. Excerpts from around 150 primary source documents provide first-hand accounts of how religion has shaped American history. Entry bibliographies and a selected, general, end-of-work bibliography direct users to additional information resources.
